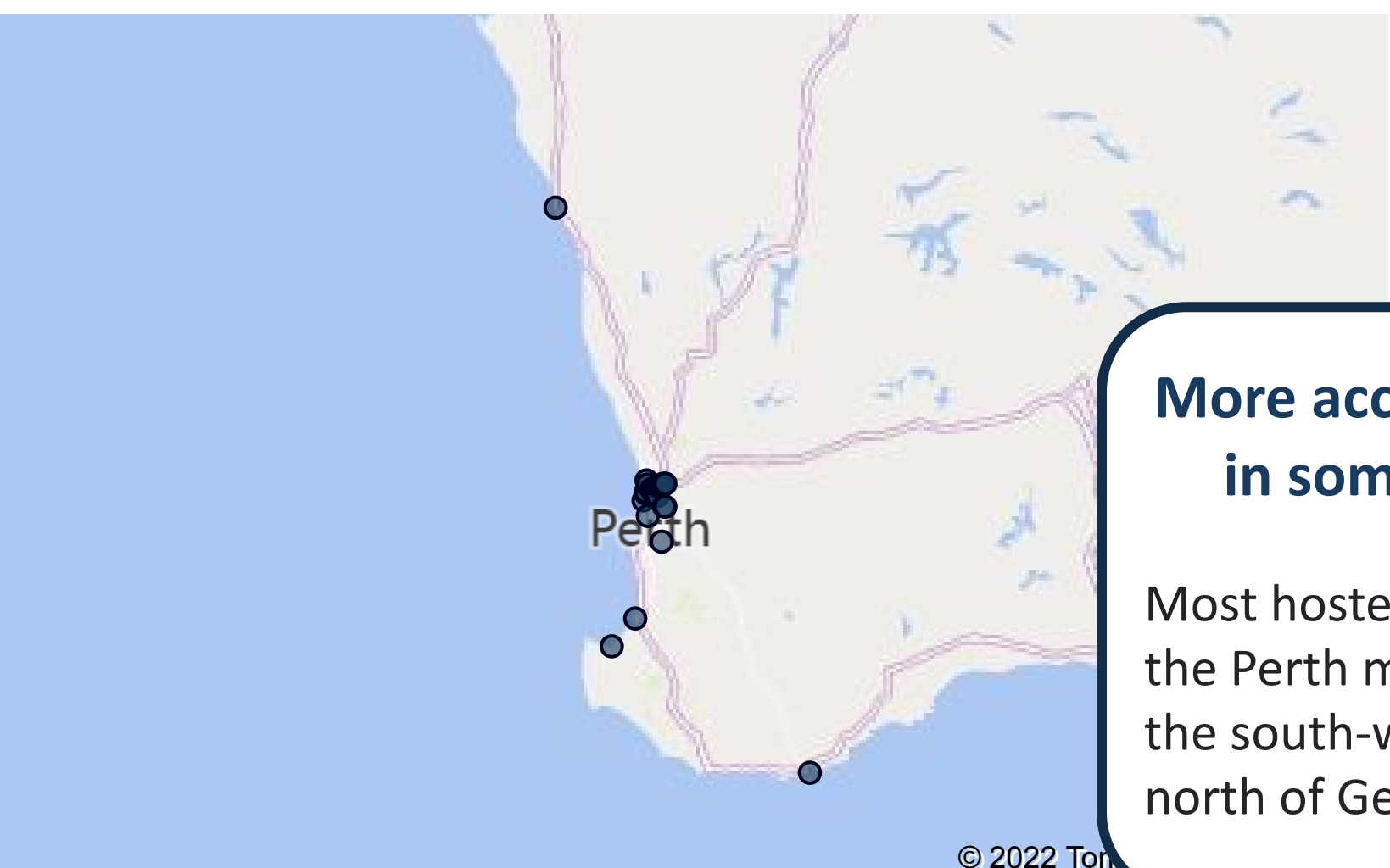

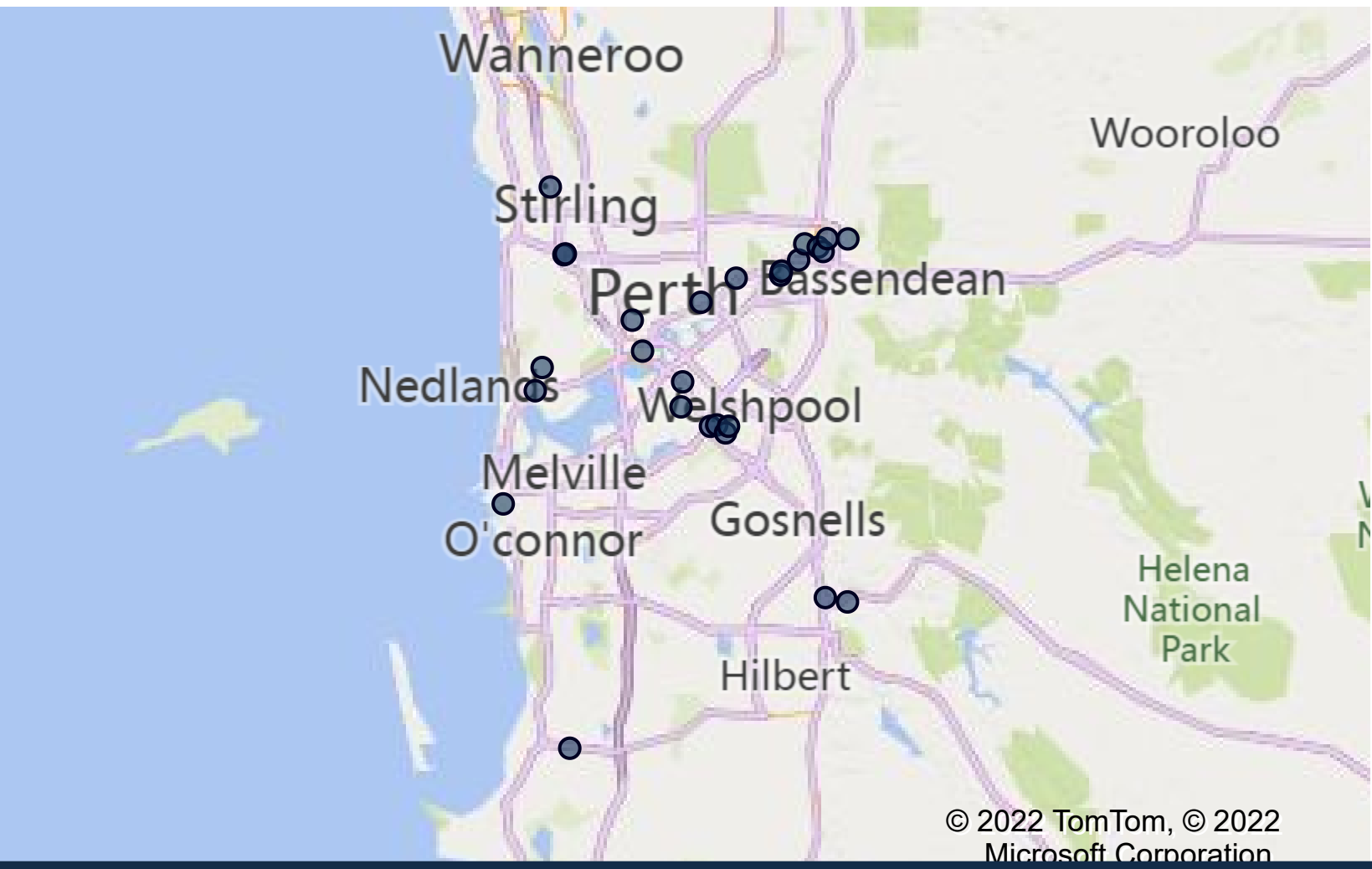

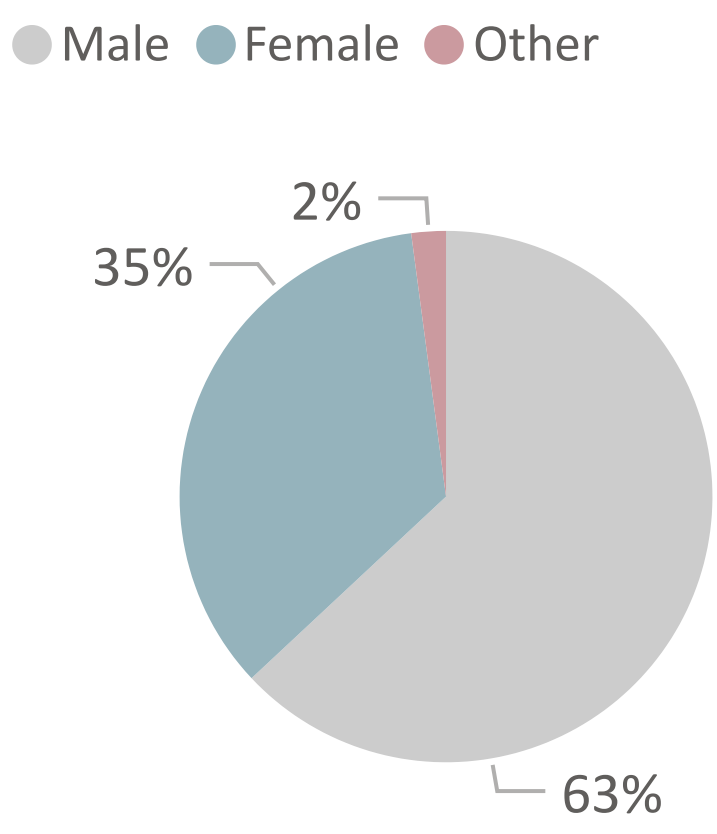
More accommodation is available in some areas than in others.

Hostel Location (Perth)

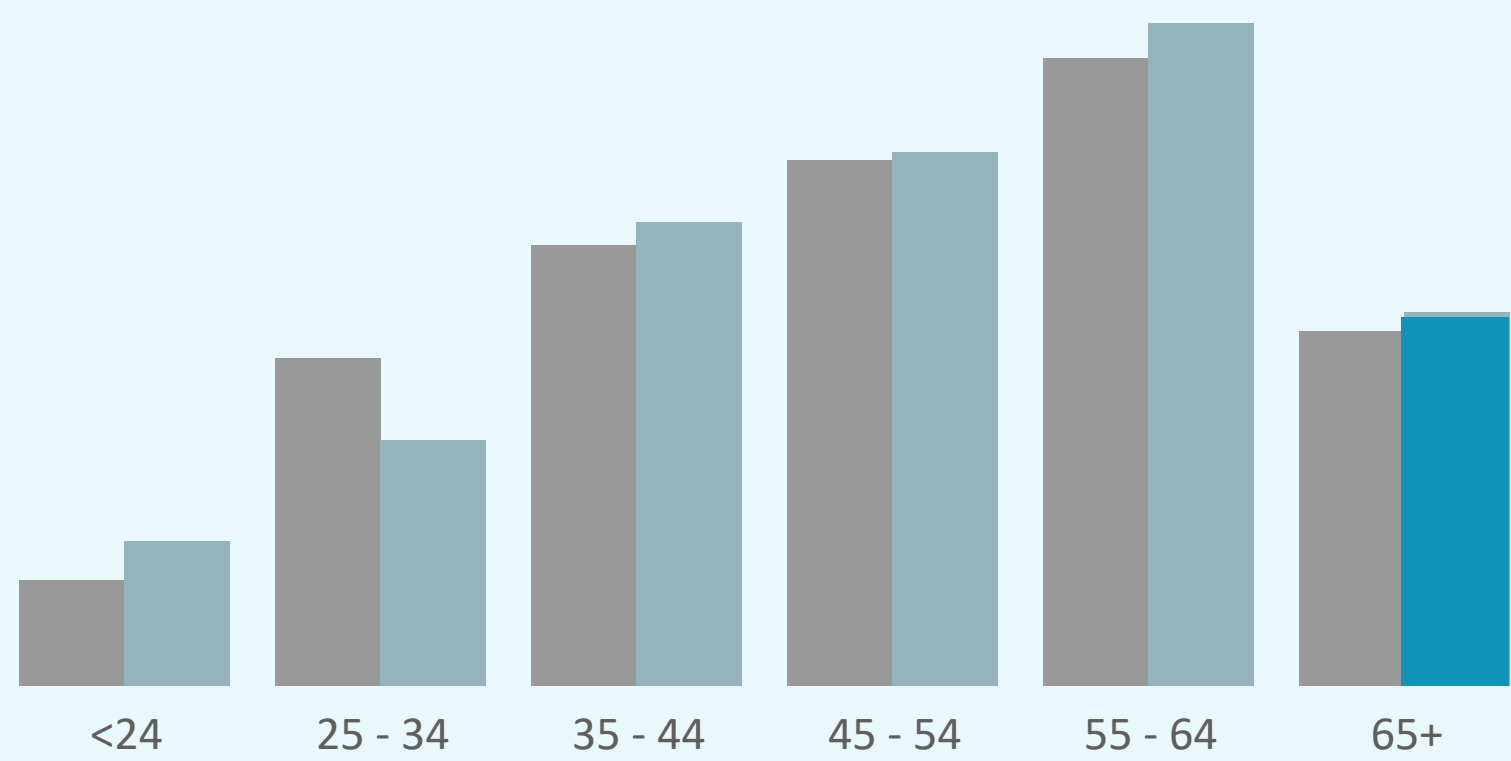


Gender Identification

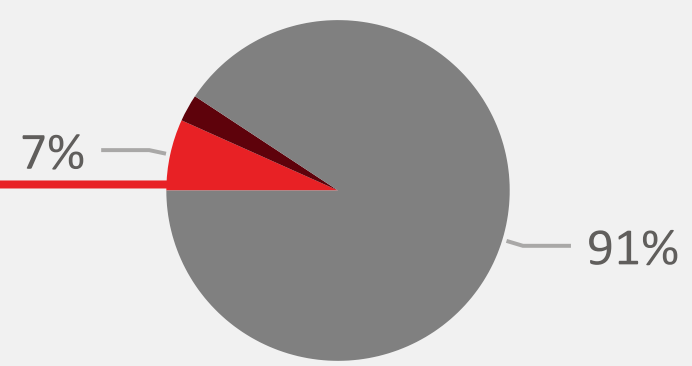
The age range is similar to 2021.

15.4% of residents are aged over 65. Some may need specialised aged care or mental health care that can also meet the needs of older adults.

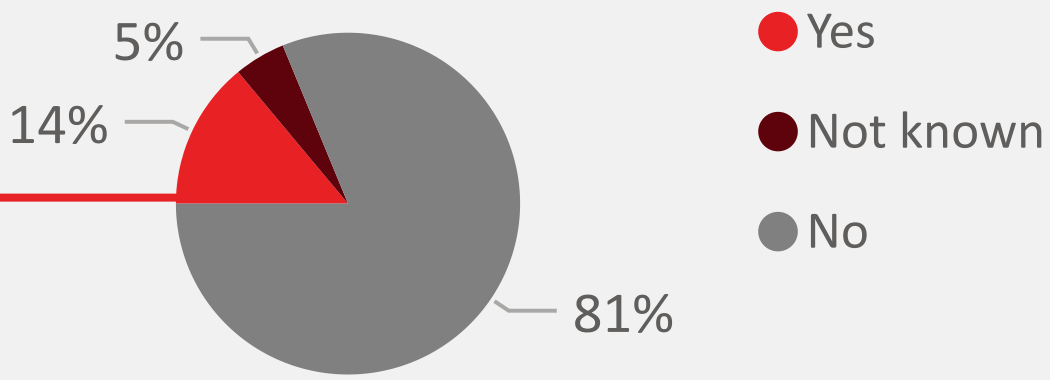
Aboriginal people are over-represented and ELD people are under-represented.

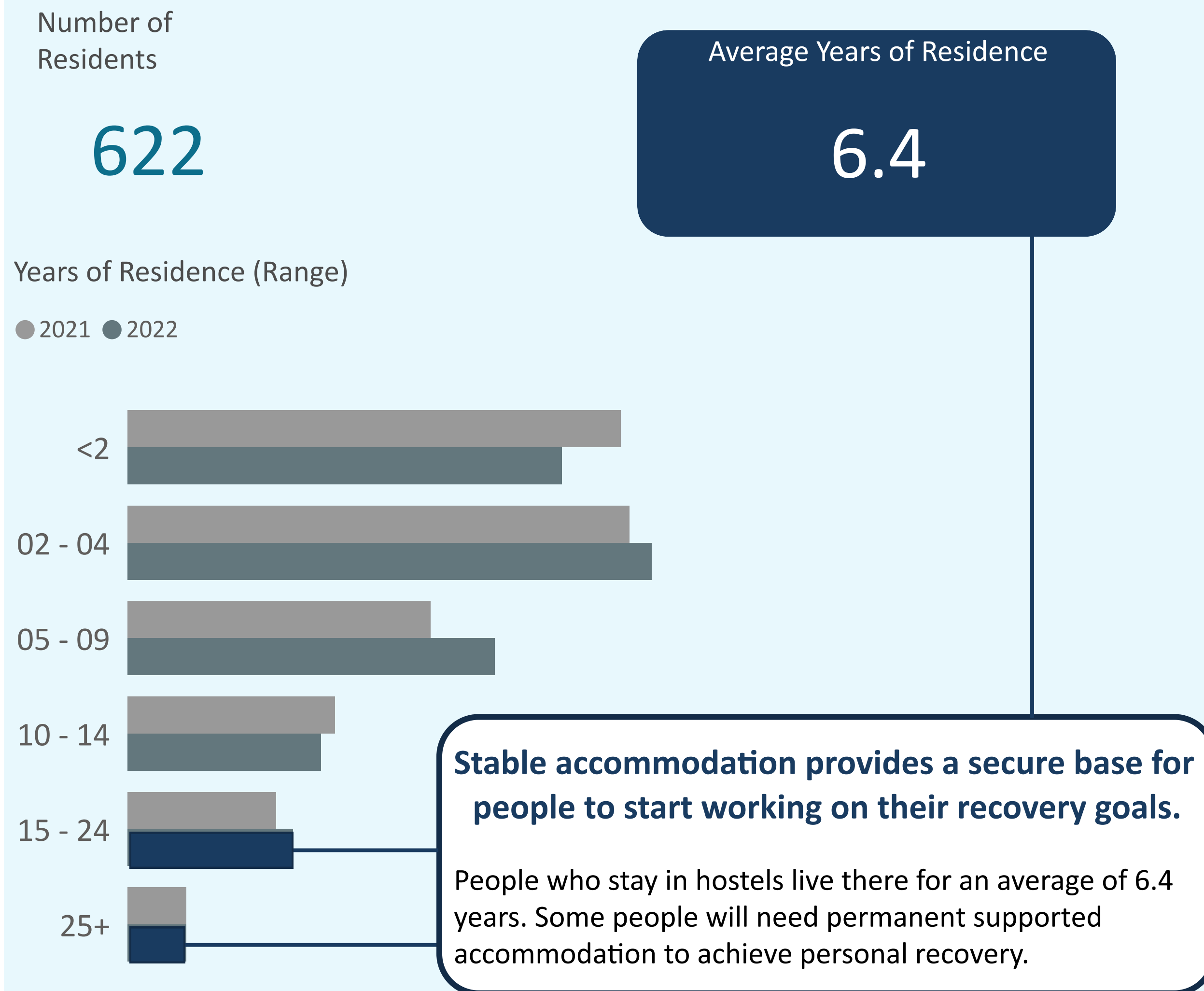

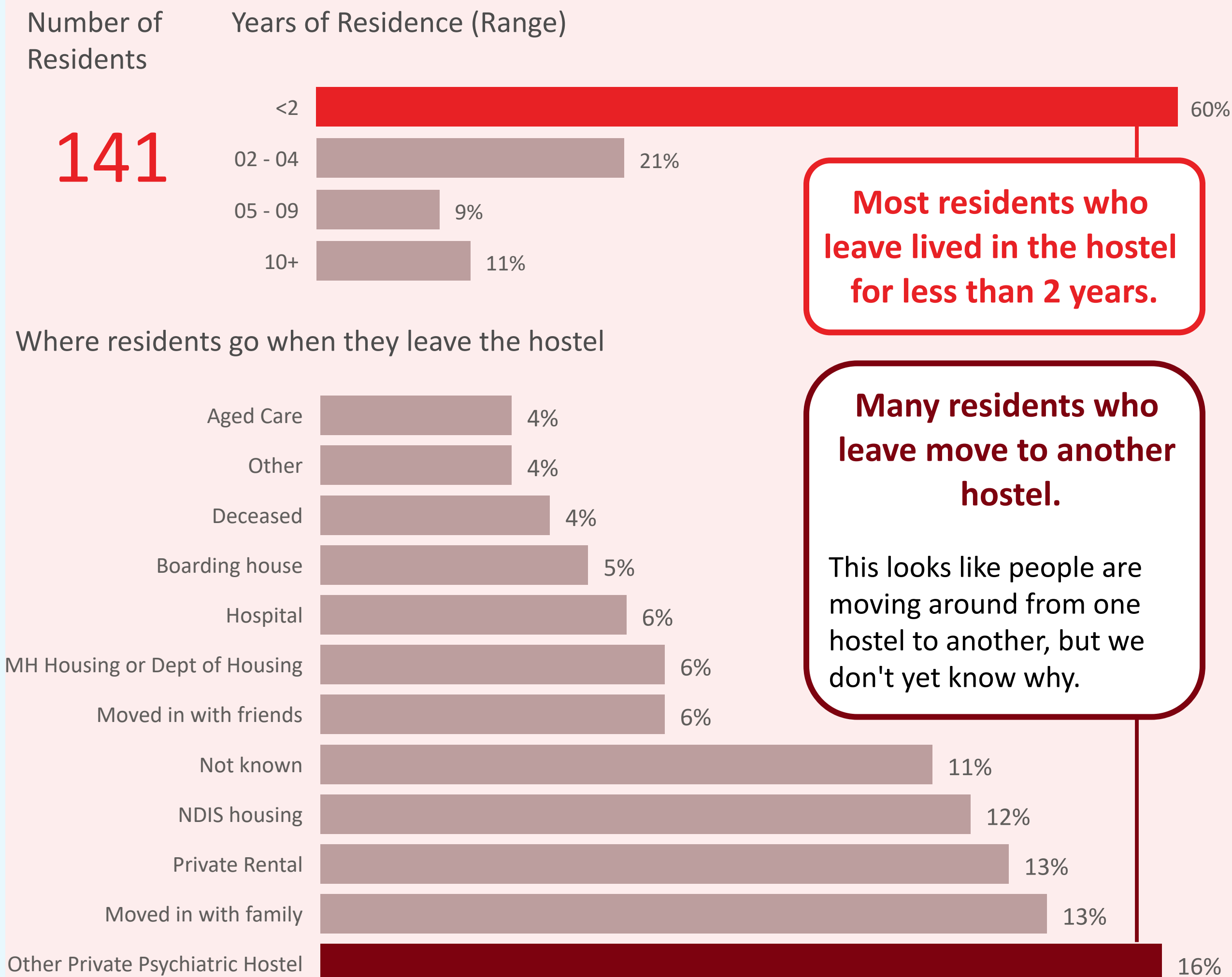
Length of Residence and Exit Location

Personal Support People

Census date: 14 January 2022

For some residents, the supported accommodation staff are their only personal support people.

Just over half of residents have a family member or friend who provides them with support. A Nominated Person is a role under the Mental Health Act 2014 Division 3, whereby a consumer can nominate a person of their choice to have the same rights as a close family member. Just over half of residents have a Nominated Person. Many residents who have a family member or friend have chosen that person to be their Nominated Person.

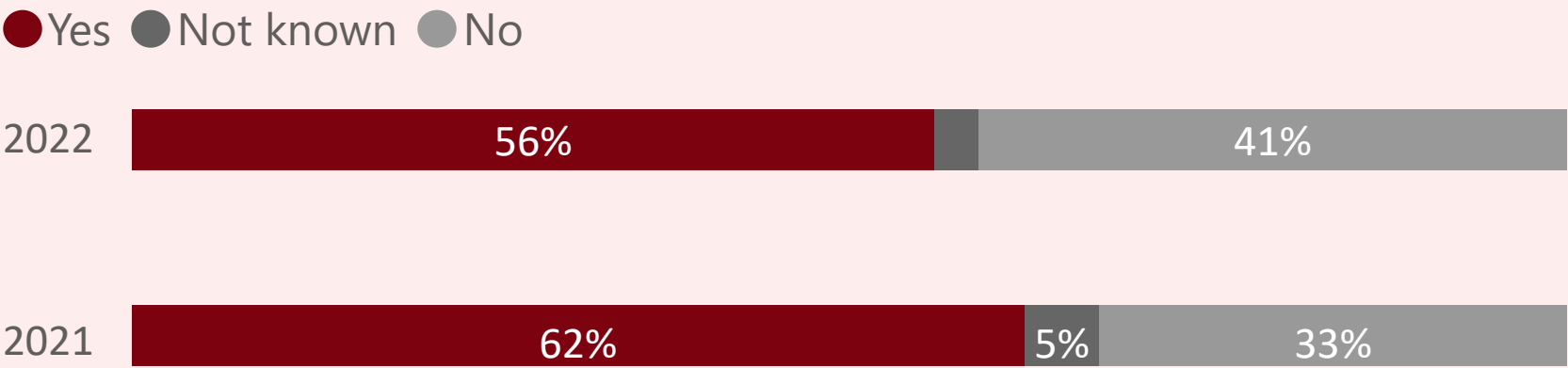
Almost half of residents are vulnerable and need a guardian and/or an administrator to protect their interests.

Guardians and administrators are independent of supported accommodation providers. They may be family or employed by the State. An appointed guardian has the power to make personal decisions on behalf of a person with a decision-making disability, while Administrators can make financial and legal decisions. The role of guardians and administrators is to ensure the person's quality of life is maintained and also to protect them from neglect, exploitation and abuse.

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) provides support to 62% of hostel residents

Private psychiatric hostels receive state funding from the Mental Health Commission (MHC) for the care they provide, but what this covers varies between hostels. Hostel residents may also be eligible for NDIS funding to cover supports and activities which are not funded by the hostel where they live. For people who benefit one-on-one support to cope with symptoms of their mental illness when going about their activities, this can enhance their personal recovery.

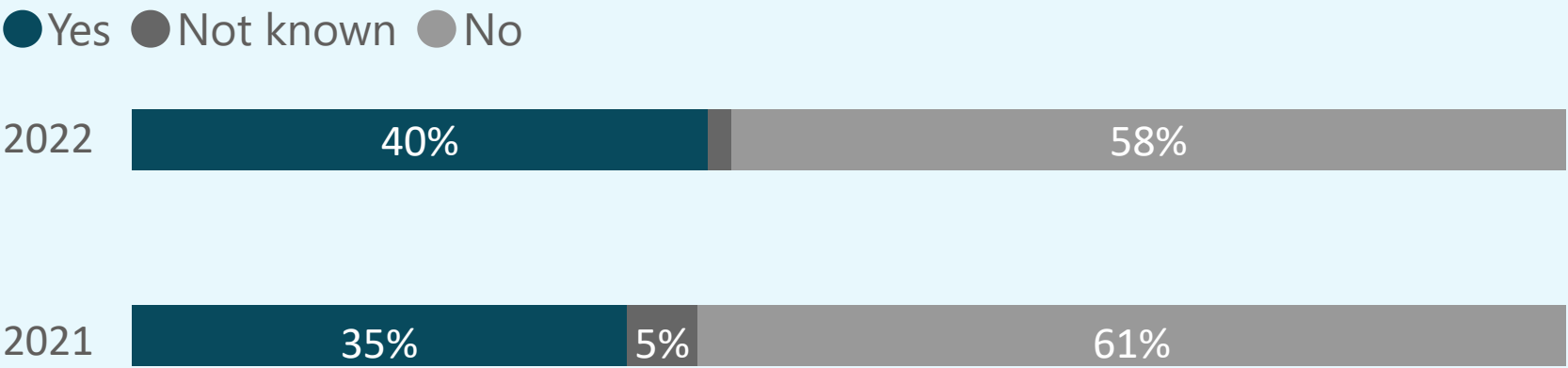
The resident has an unpaid carer eg family member or friend



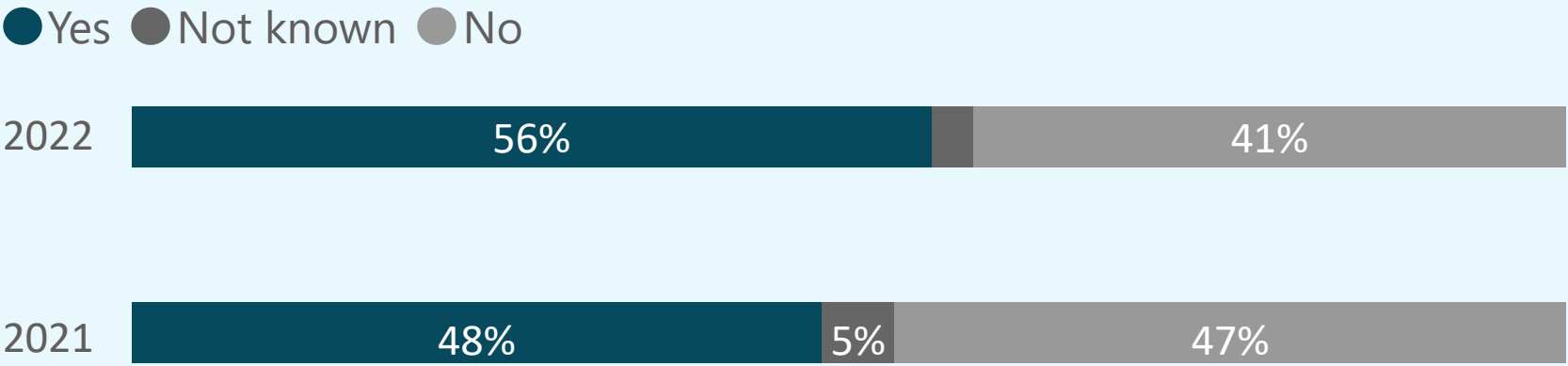
The resident has a Nominated Person



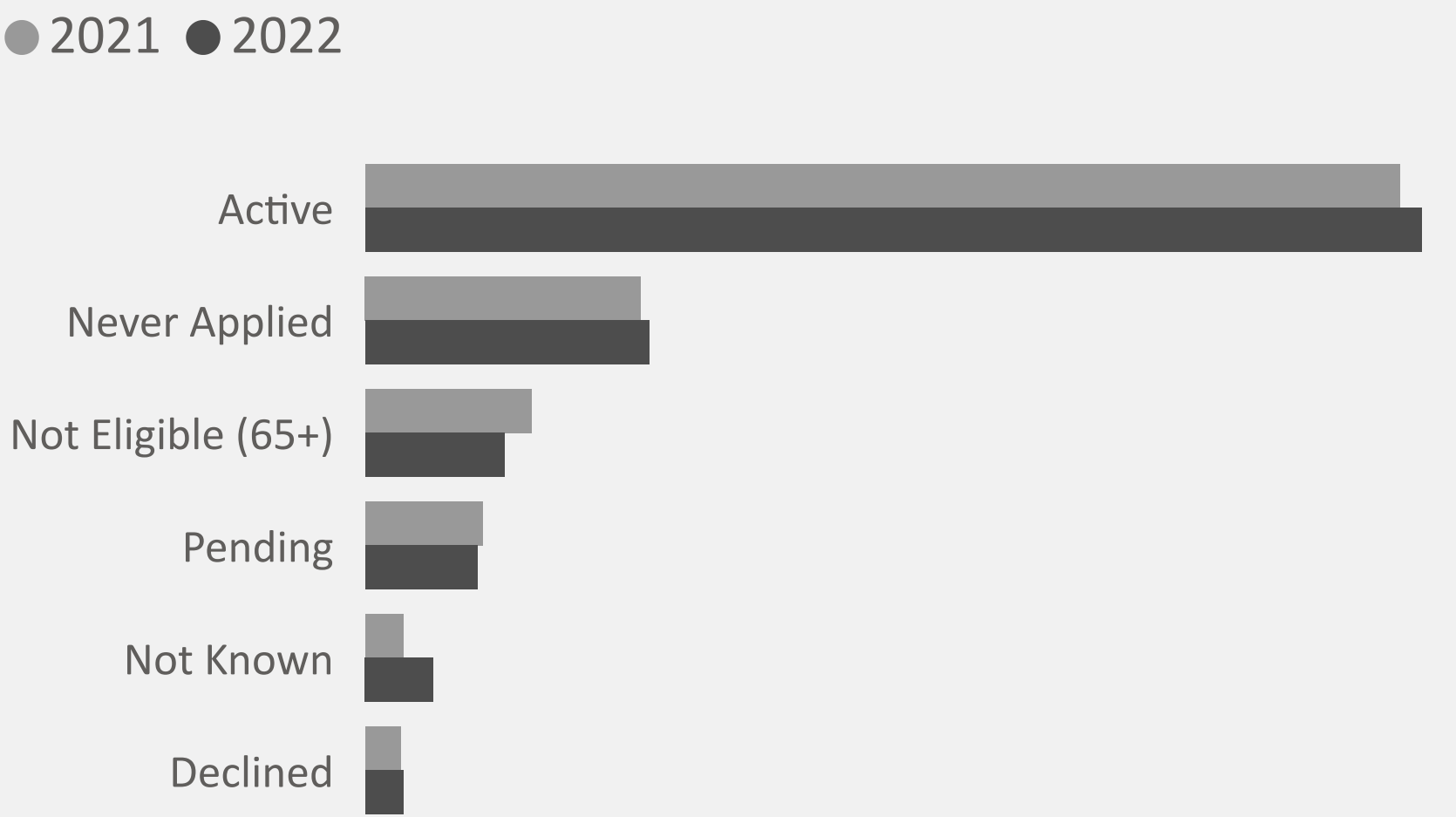
The resident is a minor or has an appointed guardian

NDIS Status



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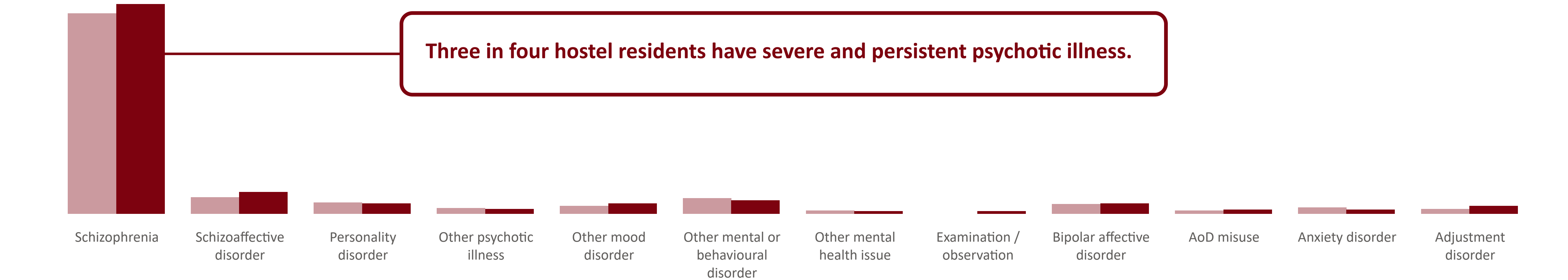

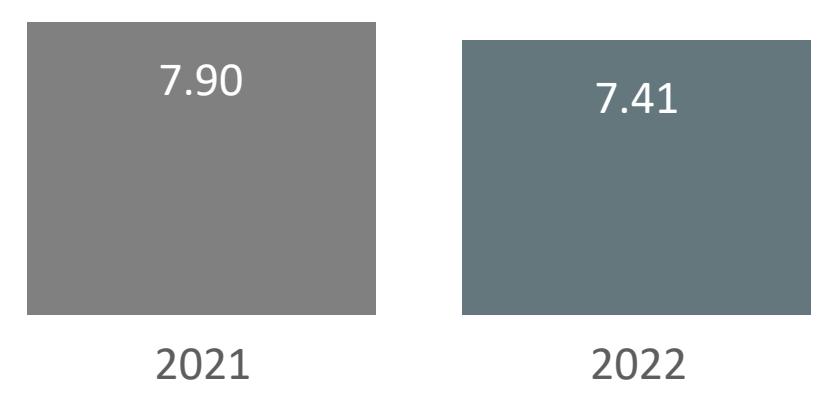
Primary Diagnosis

Health of the Nation Outcome Scale (HoNOS)
HoNOS is a measure of complexity. In adult mental health services, it should be routinely assessed every 90 days. Scores can range from 0 - 48. A higher score indicates more complex needs.

HoNOS Total (Average)



Life Skills Profile (LSP)
LSP is a measure of function, which should be routinely assessed in adult mental health services every 90 days. Scores can range from 0 - 48. A lower score means the person can manage more.

LSP Total (Average)



Kessler 10 Plus (K10+)
K10+ is a consumer-rated measure which should be routinely collected every 90 days in adult mental health services. Scores can range from 10 - 50. Higher scores indicate the person feels more distress.

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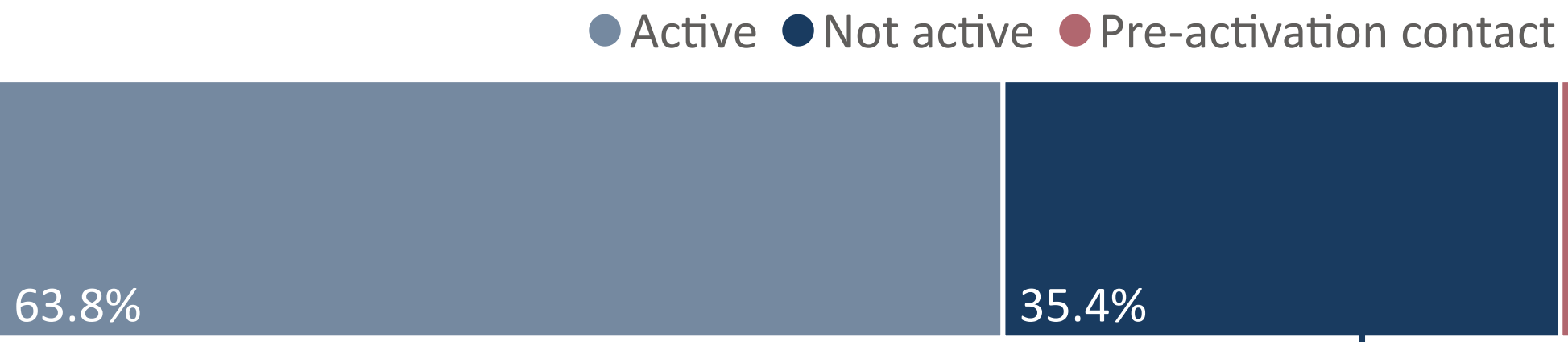

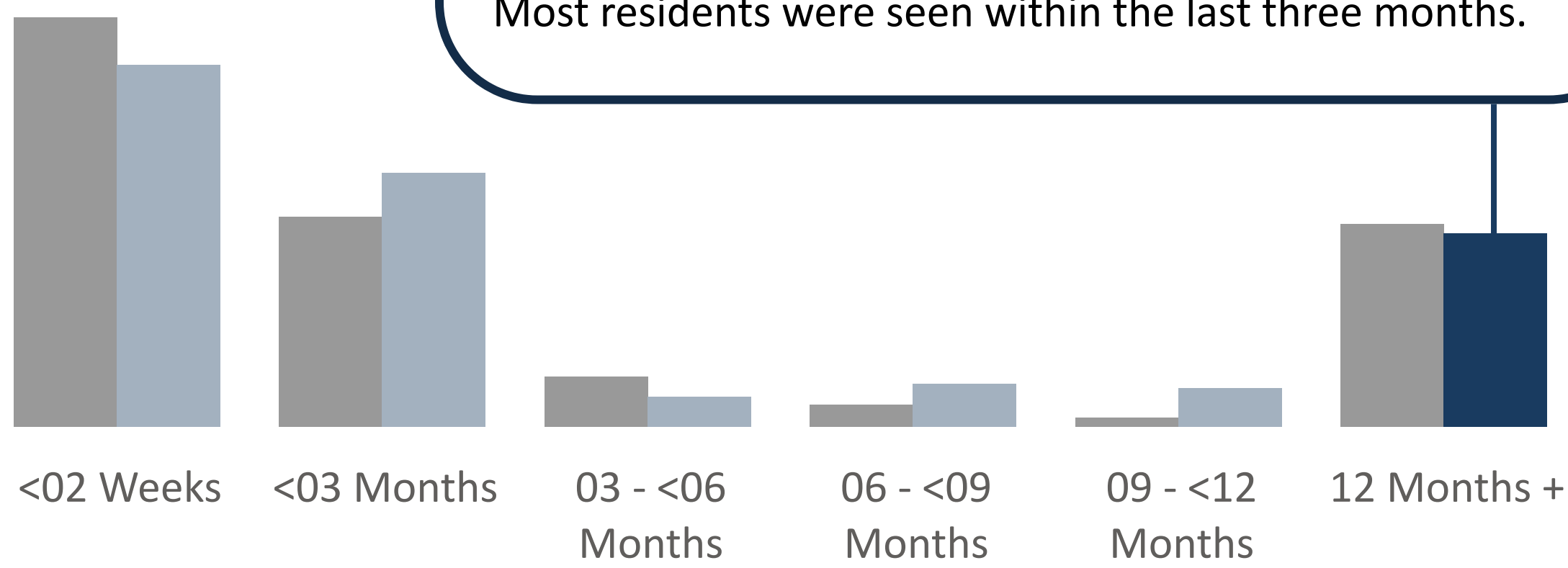
21% of residents have not been seen by a Community Mental Health Service (CMHS) in the past 12 months.

Most residents were seen within the last three months.

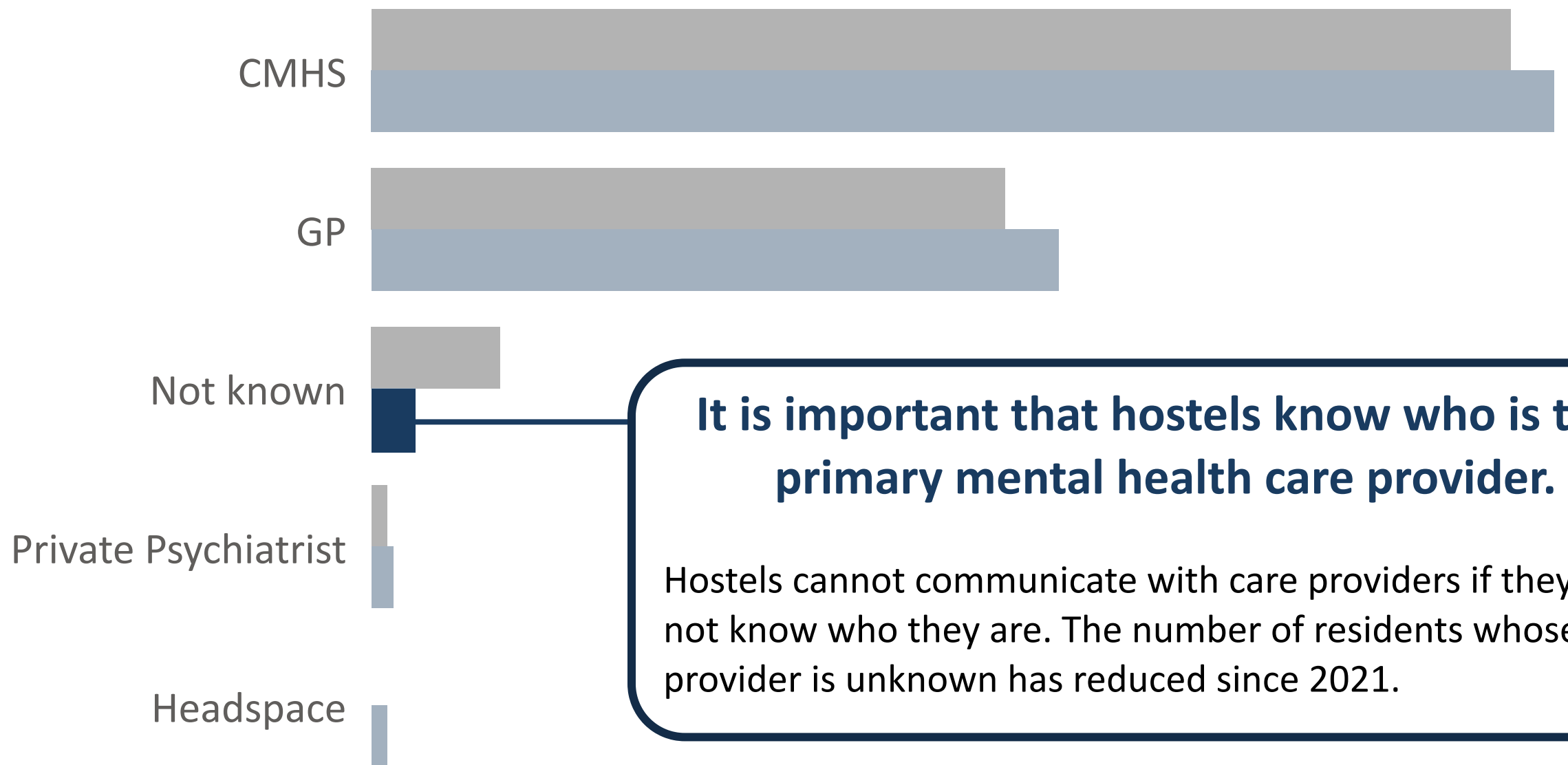
Last contact with a CMHS

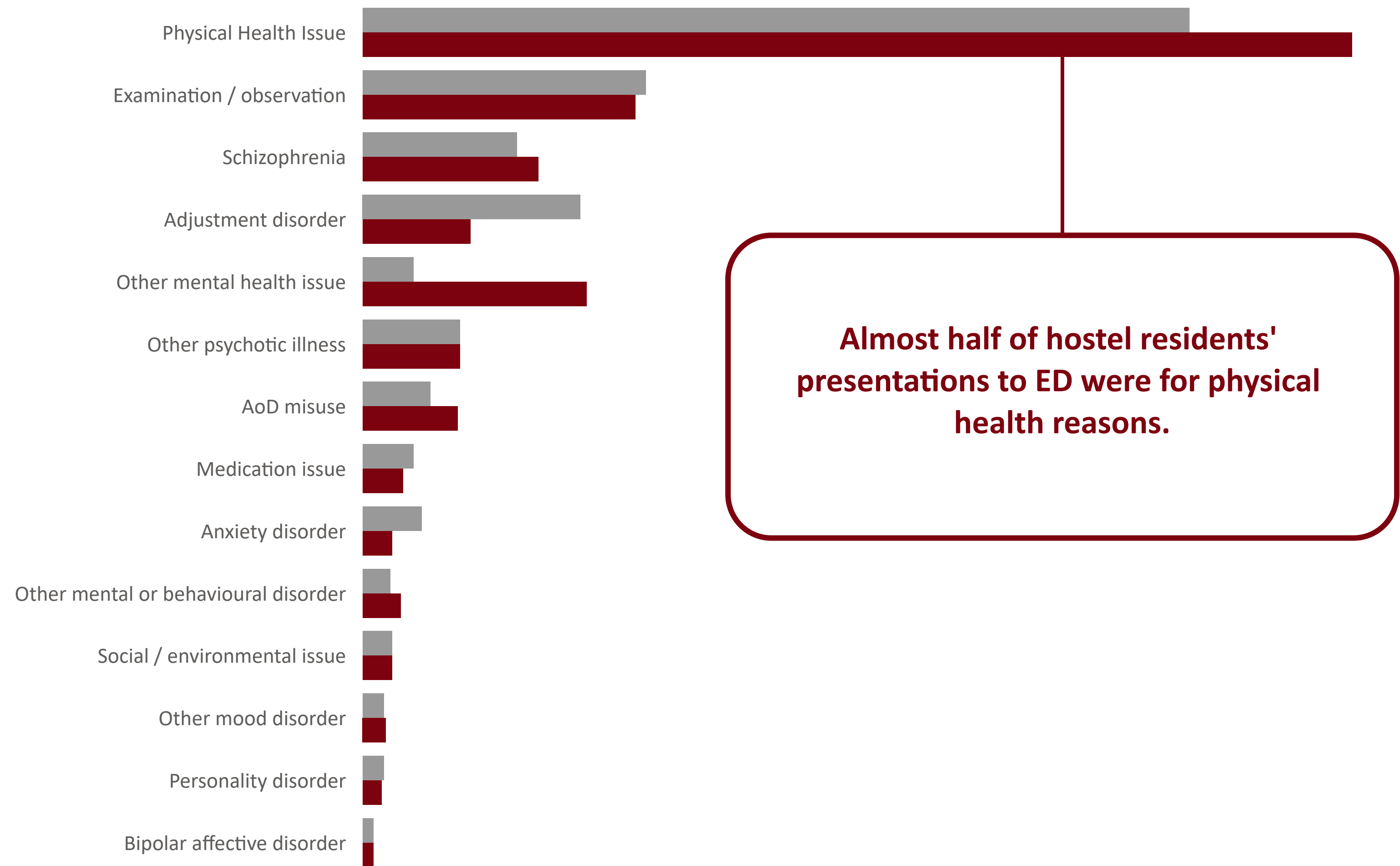

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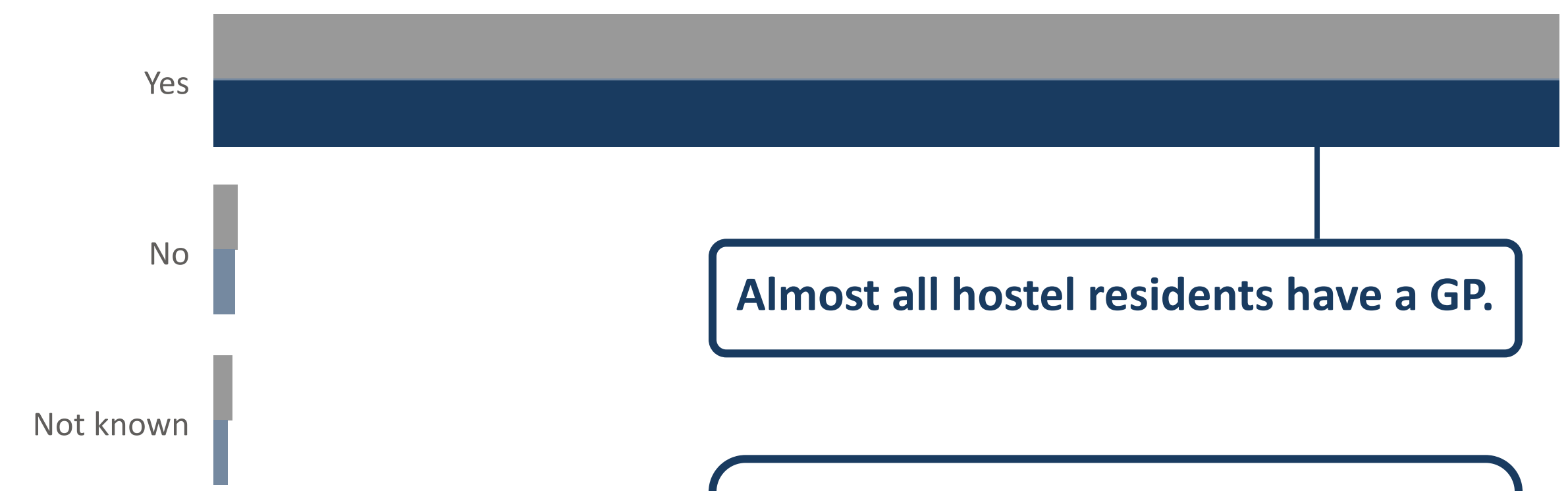

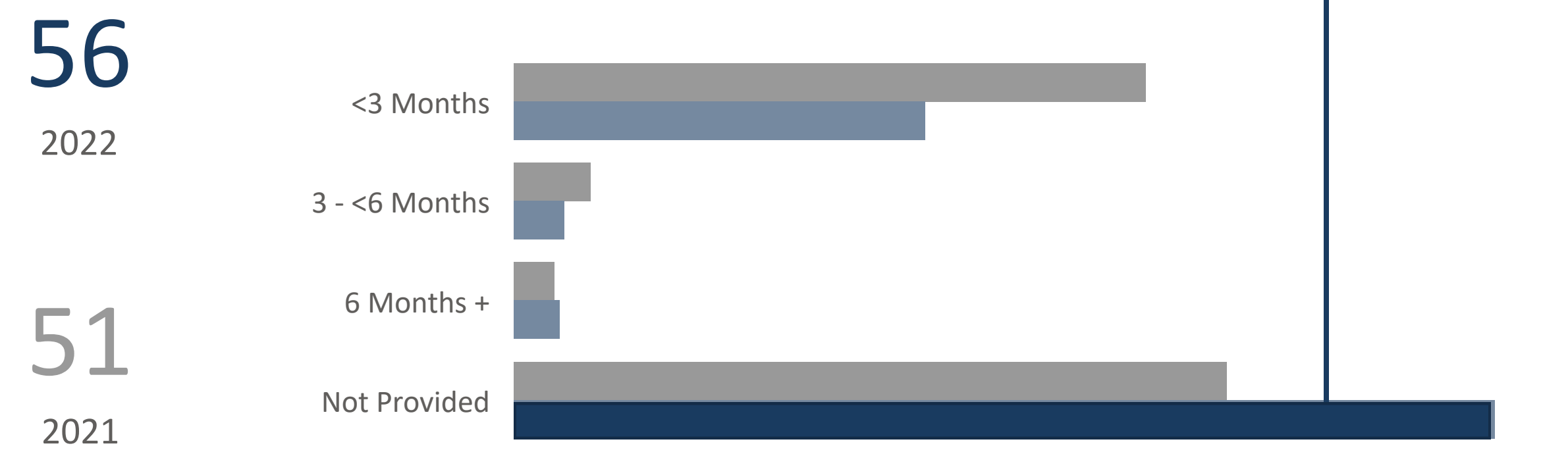
